Rotunda is generally identified as one of the blackletter variations. Scribes started to compress the Carolingian script and it transitioned into Gothic. Southern Europe never fully embraced the compression and angularity of Text Gothic and instead opted for a rounder and more legible variation. Its short ascenders and descenders made it popular for musical notation and choir books. One of my personal favourites!
