Clear Tar Gel is a syrupy, honey like gel that produces thin and thick lines when applied on paper. Various tools can be used to apply it. While a popsicle stick or palette knife can be used to apply it to paper, we will use a small squeeze bottle. It will be filled with the Gel for you to take home. We will use this gel as a resist applied to various papers of different weights. Most of this will be experimental on your part. Once dry we can apply water colour paints or acrylic paints to the designs we've created and allow it to pool within the designs further enhancing the areas to create some depth. Once dry, your samples can be cut to create cards, bookmarks or collages of your choice. Lettering of your choice can be added to your card etc. to complement the design.

**Supply List:** (Supply Fee—\$10 range)

If you do not have some of these supplies please do not go out and purchase. I will be bringing mine along as well.

- Watercolor paints or acrylic paints you may have or wish to try, your favorite colors. Gold watercolor like fine tech
- Watercolour paper that you have in different weights not big sheets but cut down to a reasonable size to work on, as we need time for gel to dry. I will also be supplying different papers.
- Brushes large to small size that work for both mediums
- Pencil, ruler, notebook, small cutting matt, exacto knife, small palette knife, blow dryer, glue stick / adhesive, masking tape, garbage bag to cover table, apron
- Calligraphy pens of your choice to letter with, inks etc. While I won't be teaching the lettering part you may want to do that once you've put together a few cards.
